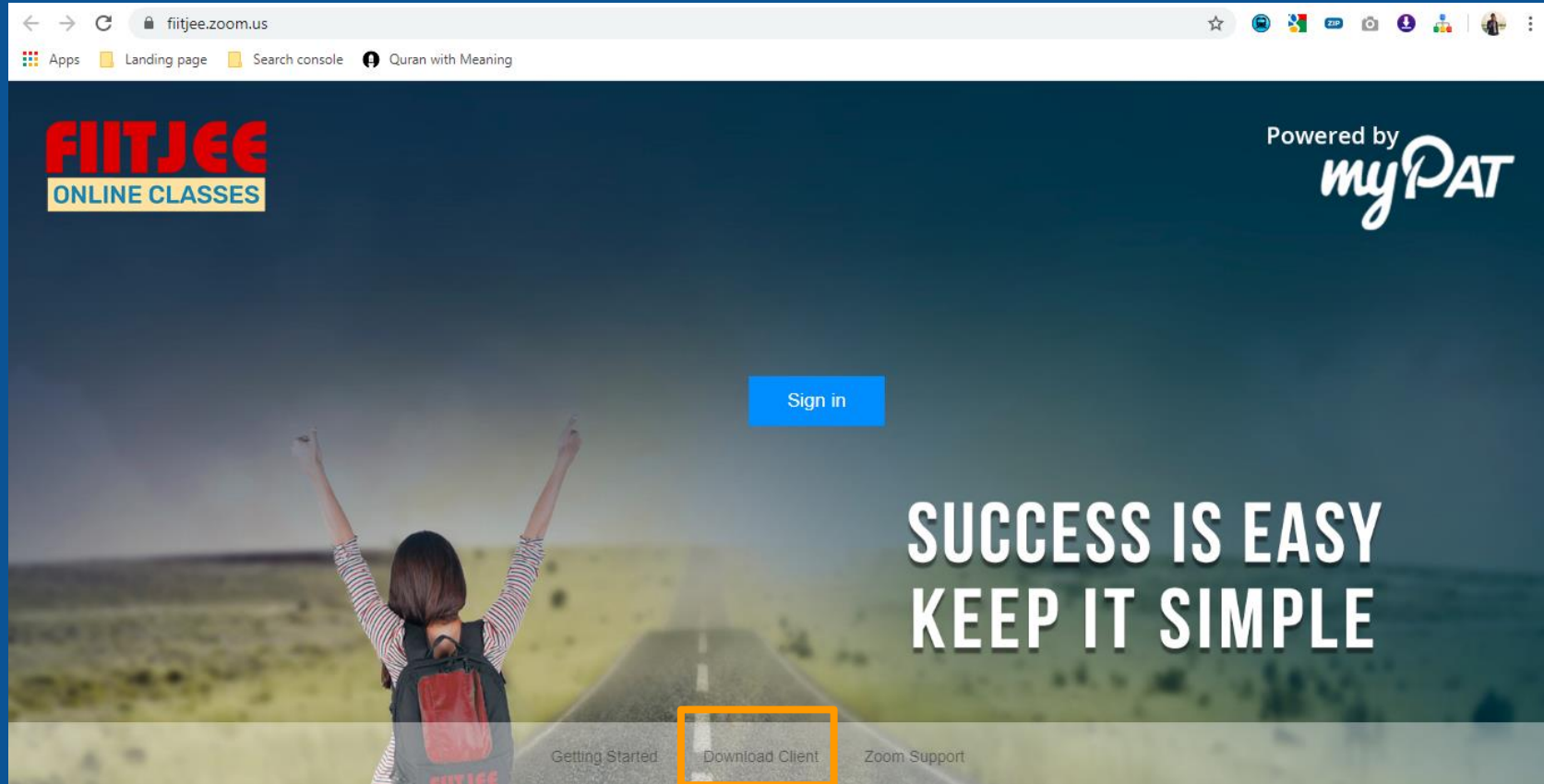

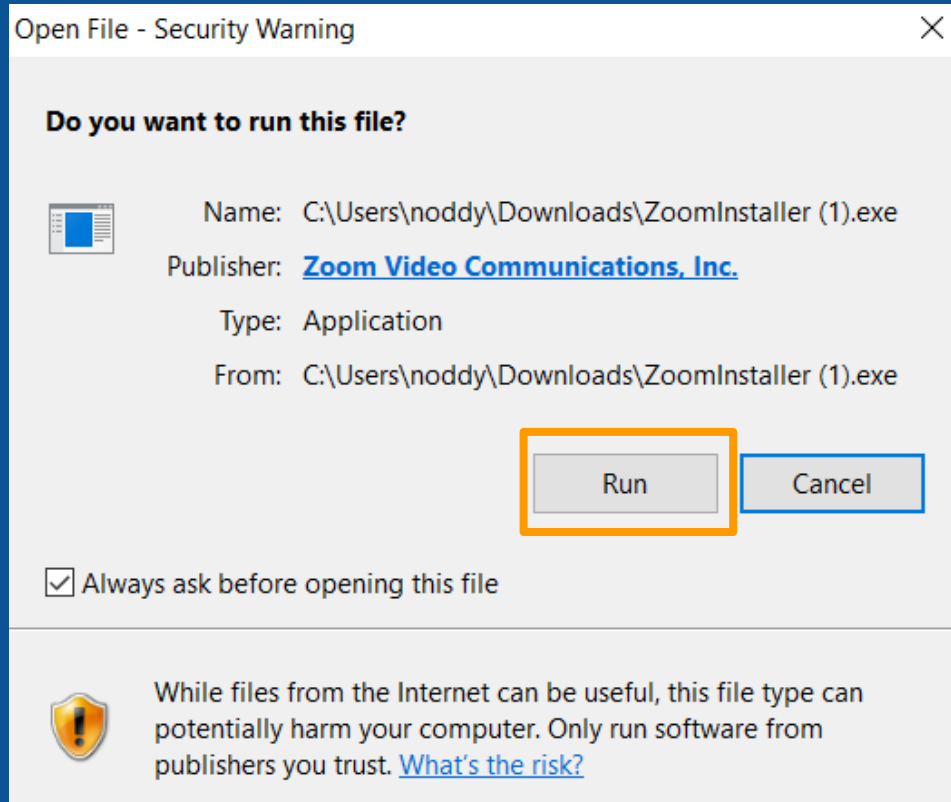

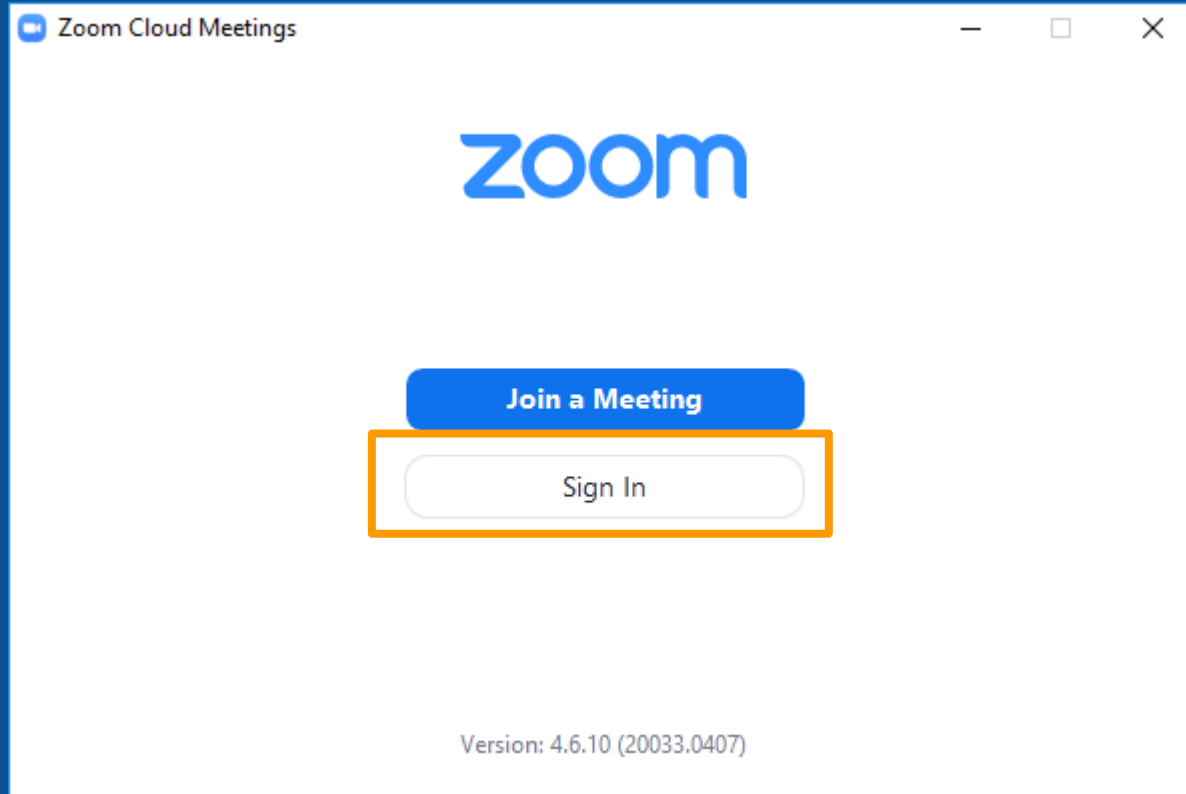

Step 4 - A popup will appear asking you to run the application. Click on the “Run” button.



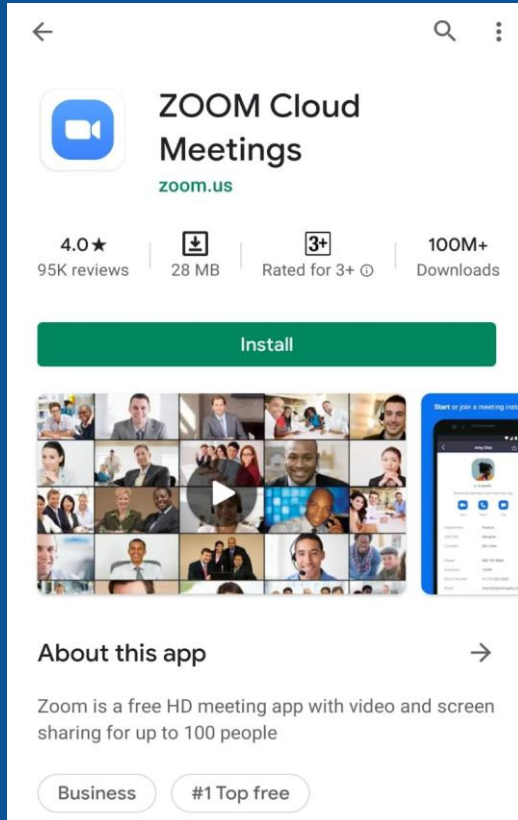
Step 5 - Your Application will get installed on your laptop. Open the Zoom application and click on “Sign In” button.



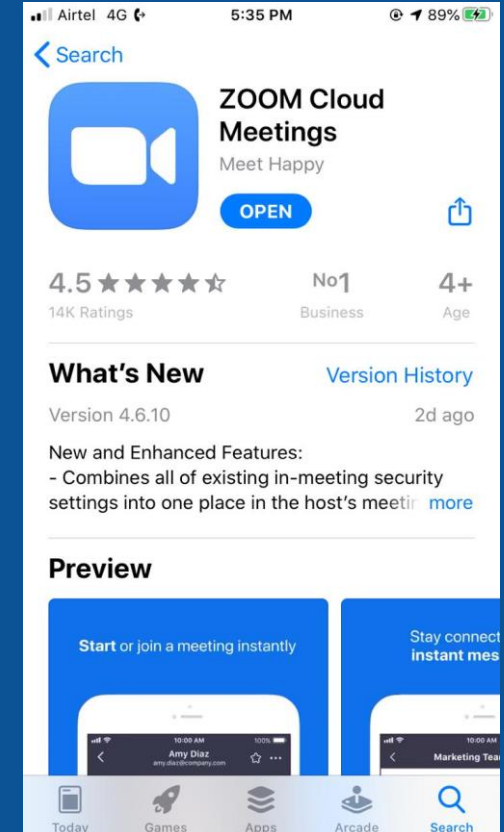
Android or iOS Mobile App

App Store(iOS)

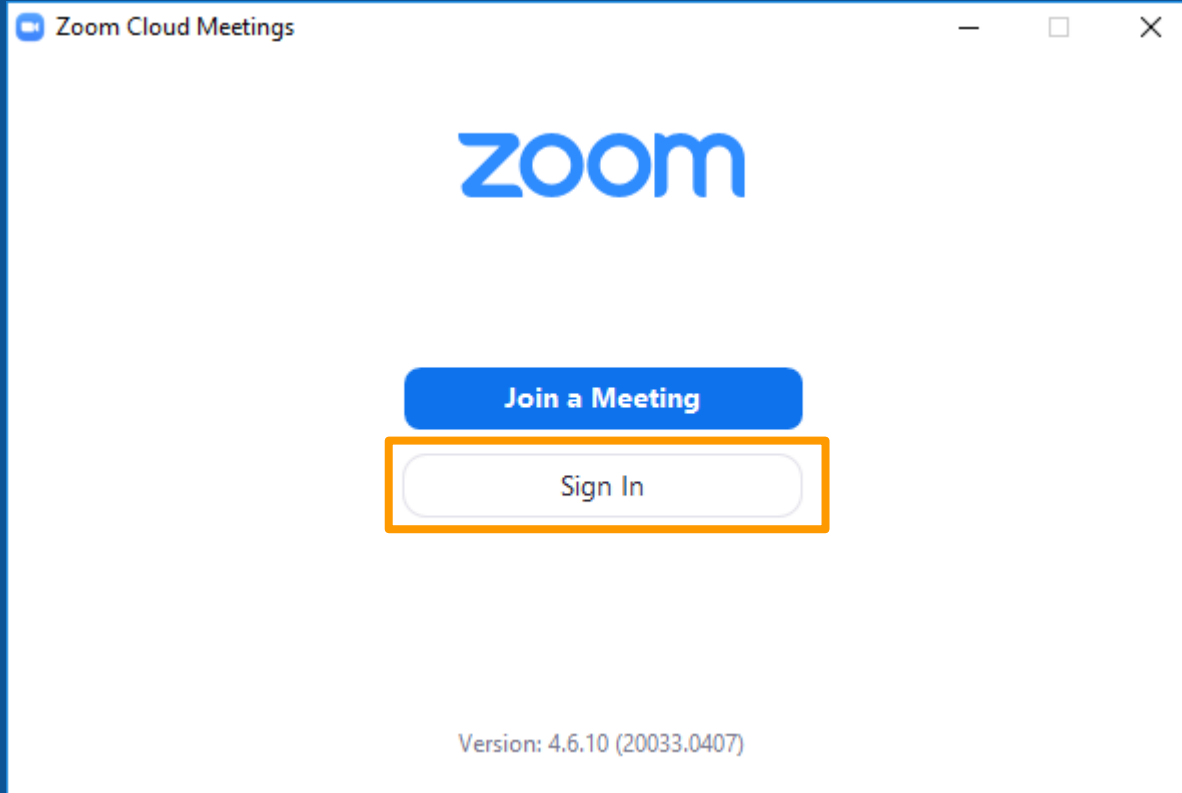


Signing In Zoom

Step 1 - You will receive a message from FIITJEE on your mobile phone in which you will be given your login id and password to sign in.




Joining a Meeting

Step 1 - Open the Zoom Application and click on Join.




Step 2 – A new window will pop up in which you have to enter the meeting id.

Every class will have a different “Meeting id” and “Password” that you will receive from FIITJEE.

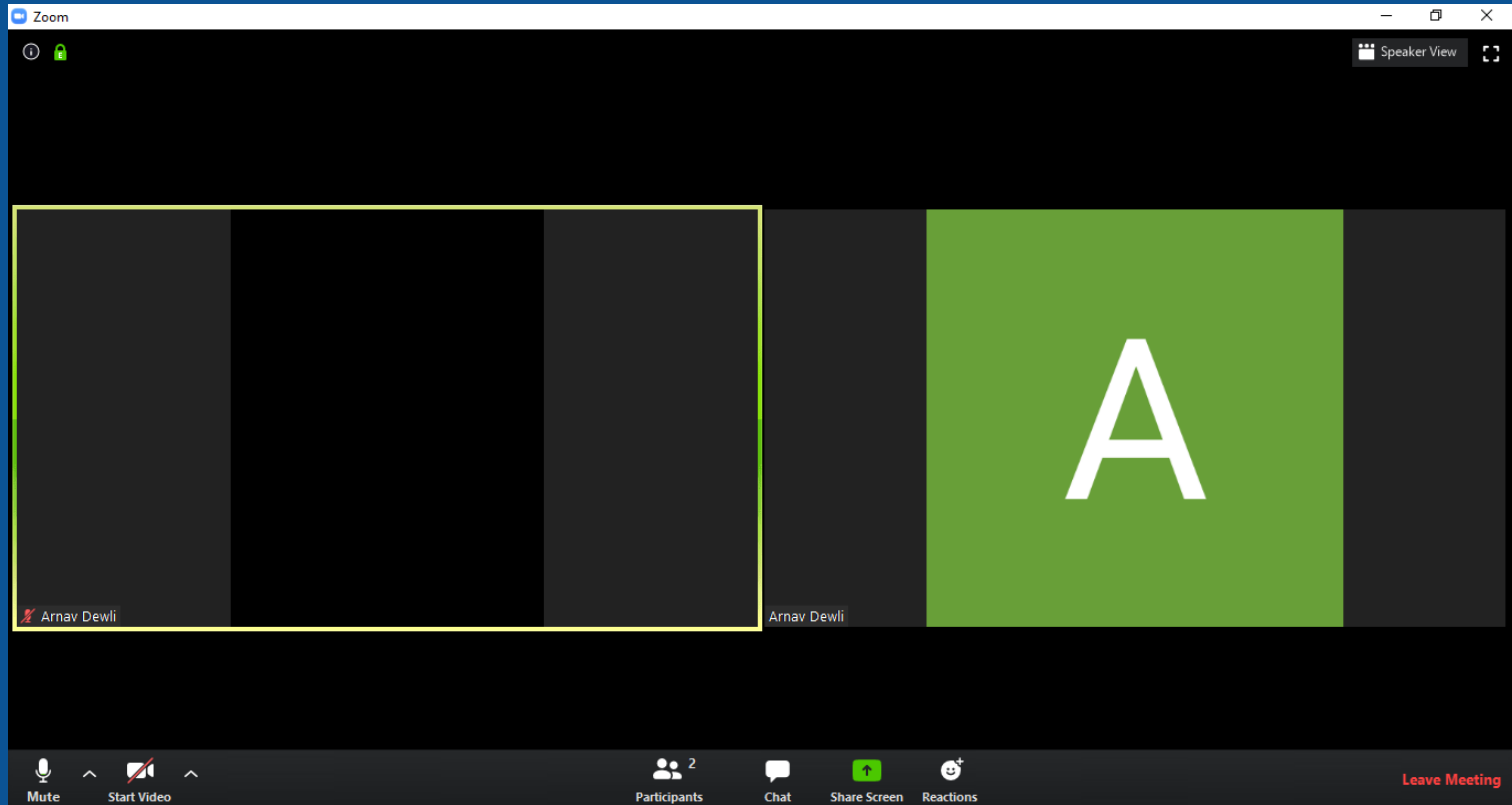
